Great & Little Kimble cum Marsh Parish Council are delighted
to announce that a new Community Garden will now be
coming to your village in 2027.

Following unavoidable changes to the on-site programme beyond our control, the opening of
the Unity Park & Garden has been moved to 2027.

This gives us an important opportunity to make sure the project is delivered to a high standard. The cooler months
provide the ideal conditions for our Volunteer Task Force to plant and establish the trees, shrubs and flowers, creating
a garden that will be healthy, attractive and sustainable for years to come.

The Parish Council supports PROJECT UNITY, as one of the ways in which we
are investing CIL tax funds received from recent property Neighbourhood Plan
developments in our area. These funds, which total in excess of £300k, have to
be used exclusively to provide new and improved physical facilities for our
community. Investments are budgeted and regularly reviewed at PC meetings,
and decisions taken are available to the public minutes on the website. We have
budgeted a total of £150k for the Unity Park & Garden. CALA Homes are paying
for the hard landscaping, as well as building it, which is a
significant contribution.

The Community & Council will be securing the freehold of approximately 2 acres
of land in return to be used in perpetuity as a Greenspace & Park. Therefore in
addition to a lovely, interesting Unity Park & Garden we'll also gain a tangible,
valuable, long-term asset.
